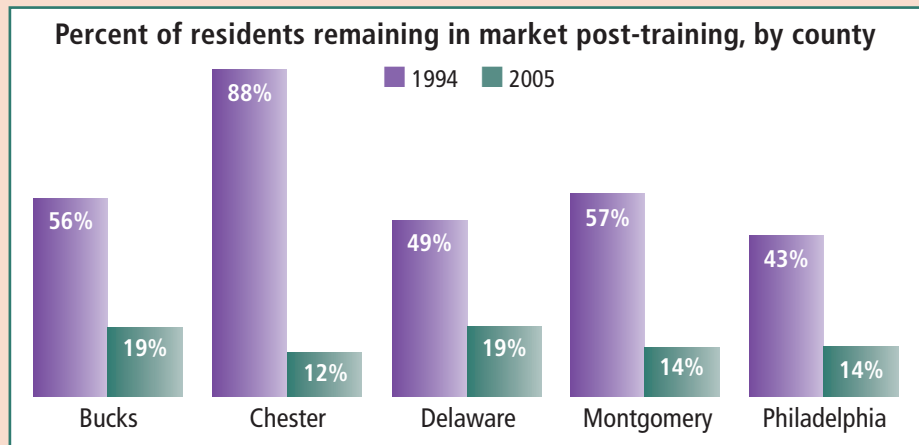


More residents training in—and leaving—greater Philadelphia

Southeastern Pennsylvania is still a powerhouse of academic medicine, attracting a growing number of residents over the past 10+ years. In 1994, 965 residents across all specialties trained in one of five counties in southeastern Pennsylvania. In 2005, that combined number had grown to 1,116.

But the number of residents staying in the greater Philadelphia area after residency has dropped sharply. Here are percentages for both 1994 and 2005 of residents who stayed in the market to work after training, broken down according to the county in which they trained.
